A people-centred approach is fundamental to modern education and management, highlighting the significance of recognizing individual needs in the learning process. This approach underpins how individuals learn and reach their potential. In this course, we equip teachers with the skills to tailor their methods to each student's unique needs, fostering an environment that encourages personal growth and academic success.

Aims

- Promote a People-Centred Approach: Emphasize the significance of focusing on individual student needs in education.
- Facilitate Individual Growth: Equip educators with strategies to tailor their teaching for the personal and academic development of each student.
- Analyse Classroom Challenges: Provide tools for identifying and addressing common problems in the classroom effectively.

Programme content

- Needs analysis: discussion of participants' concerns about the effectiveness of teaching and learning.
- Learner-centred approach: development, universal characteristics, use at home and abroad, basic principles.
- Developmental differences between students and pupils.
- Individual differences in foreign language learning: respect for individual differences, abilities, Gardner's multiple intelligence, brain learning styles and strategies, affective states, and human personality.
- Problems in the classroom - analysis: case studies, solving problems raised by participants.
